POWER UP YOUR PRAYER LIFE

Brother and sisters, I really want to encourage you to power up your prayer life. It is amazing how this most astounding and powerful asset of the Christian life is left untapped appearing then to be innocuous self- talk or words fallen on the deaf ears of dying god. **NOT!** God is not the problem in hearing or answering prayer. Lives lived in double-minded, two-mastered ways are the problem.

Here is **MY CHALLENGE FOR YOU TO POWER- UP YOUR PRAYER LIFE:**

- 1. Find a new prayer place, a new prayer time, a new prayer motive. Stop the "wa,wa" baby talk. Change from complaining and self-centered praying to kingdom minded, kingdom motivated praying. Ask for personal REVIVAL in your PRAYER LIFE! Ask for humility and boldness as a witness for Christ. Be open to God's promptings.**
- 2. Do not be afraid to praise out loud, to read Scripture out loud, to sing off key, to ask and to cry out until you run out of words to express your petitions and supplications.**
- 3. Walk the boundaries of your property and declare it as the Lord's. For His use, for His glory. Cleanse it of all evil use and yield it to the LIGHT and for LIFE!**
- 4. Go room to room in your house. Pray against all evil and darkness of the past and present. Declare every room a place for God to be glorified. Pray for the LIGHT and LIFE of Christ to overwhelm all who dwell there. Be prepared to get rid of the things that the Lord may convict you of being of no use for spiritual mindedness and growth. Obey His voice.**
- 5. Pray over your children – whether they are awake or asleep. One by one, name by name, personality by personality, sinful tendency by sinful tendency.**
- 6. Submit to the laying on of hands from your own wife or your own husband that she/ he may pray for God's cleansing, God's power and His holy oneness for you marriage and ministry together. Spiritual intimacy**

. . . praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert

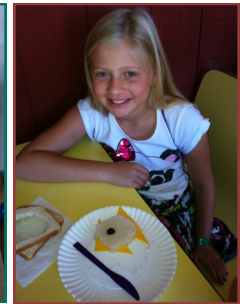

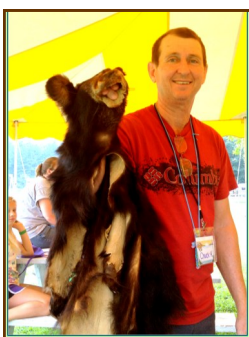
