We had our January monthly meeting at Nong Tong Lisu Village. We set three topics:

## NEWS FROM ROMANIA A WORD FROM RUSS MITCHELL

I wish to thank you for your concern about our welfare here in Romania. Perhaps this change of Prime Minister and Government Ministers will bring more unity to the country. We will see. Please continue to pray to get the right people in the right places doing the right things for the right motives.

We are having a blast of winter here – cold temperatures with high winds have closed many of the principle roads in this part of the country – schools were closed today, etc. Considering that we did not even see any snow until the 10 of January, I don't think we have anything to complain about.

Of course this weather has put our building project on a freeze. The fellows have just a few days of work to do on the outside to finish things off, but with the cold and wind, it is not possible. I'm attaching a picture that I took last Monday. I am quite pleased with how things have turned out thus far. We are in the process of negotiating with the contractor to make adjustments in the materials used to finish the interior so that we can complete the project with the funds we can access – while at the same time seeking the Lord to prove additional funds. Another \$50-100,000 would really help. So likely next week we will be able to see if we can reach consensus on materials vs. cost. On another note we were raising funds to install doors and windows before the snow flew & we succeeded – and actually were able to raise more money than the doors and windows cost. So that is something to celebrate.

I've had a couple of interesting opportunities opening up in the last few weeks. I am in conversation with several people right now about new roles that would take us out of Romania. I've been invited to Chiang Mai Thailand in May to meet with a group of regional leaders for the Global Church Planting Network. This would be training for a possible future role in Eastern Europe or Central Asia or Turkey.

Please do share with the Church body our appreciation for their support, prayers, encouragement over the years. We will have been here 15 years April 27<sup>th</sup>. Obviously the folks at NSCC have been immensely responsible for our ability to stay here and serve this long – and I would say that you have a big role to play in that. May the Lord bless you all richly and abundantly for your faithfulness!
