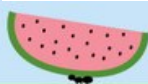

## Keeping My Spiritual Balance and Prayer

In my readings this past week, the Lord used three sources to give me great balance and clarity for a strong life. I want to share with you what the Lord brought together in me:

***Balanced and Clear Thinking:*** The Lord is good – Satan is bad. The Lord clarifies – Satan confuses. The Lord offers freedom – Satan enlists bondage. The Lord gives grace – Satan pours on guilt. The Lord forgives – Satan shames. The Lord creates contentment – Satan drives for more. The Lord loves people – Satan hates people. The Lord wants what's best for you – Satan wants what's worst for you. The Lord is a giver, Satan is a taker.

***Praying for the Church:*** For centuries, the church at large has been divided by denominational differences and doctrines. That division is easy to see from a distance. Since the church began, there have been tendencies toward division within congregations. Issues have been made over opinions, comfort, food, fairness, personalities, essential doctrines, personal preferences turned to doctrines, worship, time, money, property - you name it, some church has probably fought about it! It is more than interesting that Jesus' prayer as recorded in John 17 was greatly about ONENESS in HIS CHURCH. Here is some of what He prayed : *"I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are. I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me."* Pray for the church at large and pray for this church. The church needs prayed for.

***Praying for the Lost:*** Do we somehow doubt the reality of hell? Many around us are going to spend eternity separated from God, tortured and destitute. Shouldn't we be putting every ounce of our being into pushing the lost toward heaven and begging God to save them? Charles Spurgeon said: *"If sinners will be damned, at least let them leap there over our bodies. If they will perish, let them perish with our arms about their necks imploring them to stay. If hell must be filled, let it be filled in the teeth of our exertions and let no one get there unwarned or unprayed for."* The church should be the place where true believers rally together to pray for the lost.

The profound is often found in the simple. Let's be about the things of God more than we talk about being about the things of God. I'm praying that you will find the same balance and clarity for a strong life too!

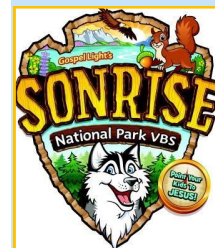
