Help Fill the Hole in the Middle!

32 Students – 30 Hours Without Food - \$2250.00 Raised – God Brings ABUNDANCE!

This past weekend, May 18, 19 there were 32 students, a mix of youth from Moniteau High School and North Street Church, who gathered for a World Vision 30 Hour Famine. Katie Kremer came up with the idea as her Senior Project and with support from a few adults, planned and directed the event! A highlight of the weekend was for the students to construct a "cardboard village" in order to spend the night sleeping in their third world housing creations made from cardboard, plastic, shipping pallets, duct tape etc. Friday and Saturday included teaching about world hunger, Bible study, discussion and reflection and prayer. Saturday included some community service projects and the day concluded with the students serving the regular community meal sponsored by the missions department of North Street Church. After serving homemade pepperoni rolls to over 60 community meal patrons, the students broke fast by enjoying a spaghetti dinner together.

The total raised to date is approximately \$2250.00. **NOW GET THIS!** On Monday, May 21, Katie received a call from World Vision letting her know that a friend of World Vision would be matching the gift raised by the efforts of the weekend 4 times over and that the window to raise funds remains open for 30 days! That means every \$1.00 raised becomes \$5.00; every \$100.00 becomes \$500.00 and \$1000.00 becomes \$5000.00 given toward meeting the crisis of world hunger! In addition, the events of the weekend will be used in future promotion of World Vision's 30 Hour Famine.

In just a few pages, Paul is able to systematically teach the Gospel, and then give practical and specific examples of how to live out this Christian life. I no longer see the Ephesians as a problematic people. I believe that Paul was writing to a fairly new group of Christians, explaining the beauty and practicality of the Christian life. I find Paul to be a deeply loving, wise, and compassionate teacher-pastor-father-figure and Christ -representative. I am amazed at both the tenderness and the directness in his communication. I am truly beginning to appreciate Paul, as well as love our Lord Jesus whom Paul represents, in a renewed and profound way. I find the letter to be tender, direct, efficacious, and reassuring. It's appealingly specific, while also giving a wonderful overarching image of God, the Heavenly Kingdom, spirituality and the Christian life. I am amazed and so very humbled by the generous Love of Christ which Paul represents in his letter.
