## ARE YOU THANKFUL?

What is the ultimate goal behind everything a Christian does? This is a question that I have started many of my discussions with when talking to different youth. The answer is simple; it is glory, but not our own glory. The ultimate goal of a Christian is to see God glorified in every aspect of our life. That goes for the good times, the bad times, the trials, the rewards, the rainy days, the winter, the beach trip or even holidays. This Thursday we will all be celebrating Thanksgiving, a holiday that is built more around food and football than what it is named after. I feel that Thanksgiving has turned into a holiday where we sit and talk about the things we want next month when we all gather again as opposed to talking about what we have already been blessed with. It's more of an un-thanksgiving if you think about it. This year we have made it a priority to talk about thanksgiving and what thankfulness has to do with the Christian life. We looked at several passages that show us how thankfulness and salvation go hand in hand; we also looked at passages that show us we should be thankful in all circumstances. However, this year I have personally been focused on the Corinthian church as I prepare my own heart for thanksgiving. We have two letters written to the Corinthian church by Paul and this is where we build our understanding of Corinth. I think it is pretty safe to say that the Corinthian church was pretty screwed up. If I asked you what Church gave Paul the most heartache we would probably all say Corinth. This really hit me from a Pastoral point of view, as Paul was dealing with the church at Corinth who was probably the biggest frustration to him he tells them in 1 Corinthians 1:4 **that he gives thanks for them** while it was this passage that sparked my interest in studying Paul's writing to Corinth as my thanksgiving study, it was 2 Corinthians 4:15 that received most of my attention this month. Paul starts out the verse by telling them that it's not for his own sake that he is sharing and taking all this time, it's for theirs. He tells them that he shares because the more people who hear the message of grace and receive it the more thanksgiving increases. The more thanksgiving is increased the more Glory God gets. Paul says, "I share so they may become thankful which results in God being glorified." It's the ultimate goal of a Christian. Not just this Thursday, but everyday! Let's take the example of Paul and share grace to increase thanks which results in an abundance of God's glory.
