One of the highlights of serving in Thailand for us is ministering to and helping out at the Children's Ministry in Chiang Dao. What We're Learning

During our **Take Five** Wednesday Evening Children's program, we will be using curriculum from *Children Desiring God* called, "The Call of God." In contrast, the goal is two-fold: to help children understand 1) that God is calling people to Himself and 2) that this world is not the only world there is; there is also a spiritual world and what happens in that world is what really counts.
