Easter Sunday at NSCC About A Mile to Lead Worship


You are encouraged to **invite everyone you know** to come to NSCC for EASTER SUNDAY, April 20, 2014! Our day will start with **Sunrise**


The Seven Last Words of Christ Good Friday, April 18 at 7:00 p.m.


