Your gold and silver are corroded, and their corrosion will be a witness against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have heaped up treasure in the last days." **Sometimes the wealthy hoard more and more, are driven by greed and live luxurious but miserable lives.** This they do to their own credit/discredit and to their own name! That's not good.

I Timothy 6 teaches that we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. We learn that people who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction. We are not to be arrogant nor are we to put our hope in wealth. The clear contrast is perfectly made - the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil BUT the greatest gain is godliness with contentment. **We are to put our hope in God. In doing so, we find satisfaction in being rich in faith and rich in good works - to the glory of His Name!** Now, that's good!

Really though, I am rich in the eternal things of God. And you are too! I really am one wealthy preacher!
