


THE LIFE READY WOMAN and STEPPING UP

Family Dedication Sunday

Sunday, October 5th has been set aside to rejoice in the gift of new life amidst our congregation. If you have a child born after October 1st, 2013 and would like to participate in a recognition and blessing on Sunday, October 5th during 10:15 worship, please notify the church office at 724-282-7700 or by email at shannon@northstreetchristianchurch.org by September 26th. Please supply the child's full name, date of birth, parents' names, and a small photo (optional). Photos received will be included on a special display. Family Dedication Sunday was formerly known as Infant Recognition Sunday and has recently received some clarification as to its purpose. More than simply recognizing newborns and their families, the intention is to praise the Lord for the gifts of new children and their families, to ask the Lord's blessing and have each family commit their own family to the Lord and His ways. Joshua 24:15 issues the challenge - "choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve . . . but as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD." The dedication is family by family with the congregation of NSCC presenting ourselves as servants of the families who desire to raise their children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. Our congregational desire is to uphold the commitments we make, therefore guidelines have been proposed in order for a family to participate in this dedication. We ask that those participating be in regular attendance at NSCC for at least 3 months prior to the dedication Sunday – since July 1, 2014 – and that they intend to be a part of the life and ministry of NSCC for the foreseeable future. These guidelines will help us all, families and congregation alike, to fulfill the commitments we make to God and one another on Family Dedication Sunday.
