
Today's Sermon: Conversion of a True Believer

Sermon Title: Unrecognizable
Passage: Colossians 3:1-14

While attending school, Jesse was senior pastor at Detroit Christian Church in Detroit, IL. Jesse and Jessy recently moved back to Butler while Jesse completes various phases of training required for Navy Chaplaincy. They are looking forward to learning where God will use them for His kingdom in the coming months.


Soup & Salad Lunch and Easter Craft Day on Sunday, March 4


