


Living Christ = Living Hope

In Luke 24 we read the account of when Christ appeared to two individuals who were leaving Jerusalem and heading for Emmaus. This would have been roughly a seven mile journey. As they walked, the resurrected Jesus Christ walked with them revealing how the Scriptures point to Himself. It's an amazing conversation that the Bible gives us very little of. As I read that passage this week, I found myself intrigued with the section from vs. 18-24 where these two individuals, unaware that they were talking with the resurrected Jesus, told Jesus about Jesus! As they spoke with Jesus they shared that He was a prophet mighty in deed and word and how they had hoped that it was He who would redeem Israel. While reading what these two individuals spoke, I was drawn to the fact that they spoke in past tense. The death of Jesus shattered their hopes. They no longer had hope that He was the Messiah or the Prophet, emphasizing that He wasn't anymore. You can almost see the sorrow in these two faces as they lost hope in Jesus yet longed for the ending that they thought He could bring. Without the resurrection they were left without hope. Without the resurrection they needed either a new being or a new plan. But when Jesus revealed Himself to them, it was the resurrected Christ that restored hope. It was the resurrected Christ that fulfilled God's plan. We live in the final age, the post resurrection age. Jesus Christ is the Messiah, He did fulfill God's plan, He did die appeasing God's wrath against us, and He did rise conquering death and the grave. The question for you is, have you met Jesus like these two characters from Luke 24? Have you met the living Christ and been given a living hope through Him? We can be brought near to God through Christ and His accomplishments, so marvel at the being of Jesus and worship Him as the living King of Kings!




April 5 & 19 at The Legacy House you will find a wonderful God oriented ladies Bible study led by Alishia Cousins.








NEW BIBLE STUDY Tuesdays at 7pm


