Today we start a five week series from Ephesians 4. Ephesians 4 is a monumental chapter in your Bible for what the church is and what the job of the pastor is. God has used this chapter to shape my understanding of what my role is here at North Street. Throughout this short series, we will talk about the unity of the church, the uniqueness of the members in the church, the role of the Pastor, and finally what our life and walk as Christians looks like.

Submission to Gods Word

We have taken the beginning of our year to dissect the idea of expository preaching. In expository preaching we are setting forth the meaning of the text and covering all of it. We teach God's word this way for several reasons including:

- 1- It's the example we see in the Bible
- 2- It establishes the authority of God over those hearing it
- 3- Because Christ is the head of the church
- 4- Because the Holy Spirit works in accordance with the word of God
- 5- It shows submission to Gods Word.**

When people submit to scripture, they are submitting to the authority of God. If a preacher is bringing his own ideas or pushing his own agenda, it can have people submitting to a false authority. Your preacher has no authority over you, but the word of God does. When we preach the text and all of it, we are submitting to God's word and valuing it for what it is, from God.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 - "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."

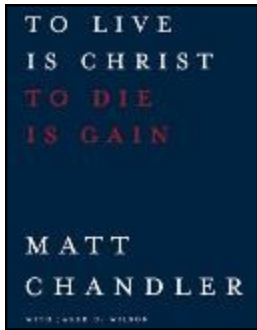

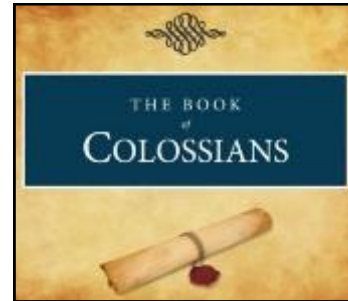

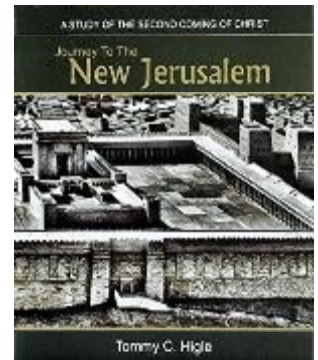
Denise Kerr is continuing through a series on the Armor of God. She is using the series from Priscilla Shirer as they study this important teaching from Ephesians 6.

Thursdays at 10:30am

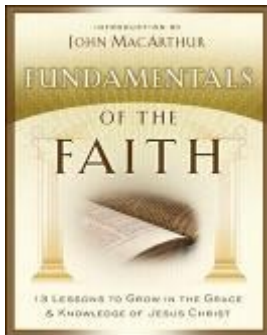
John Gumper will be teaching "Journey to New Jerusalem" on Thursday mornings at 10:30 in the dining room. Come and join us!

John Maze has started a study on "Fundamentals of The Faith" Come join him on Tuesdays at 106 Reich Ave, Butler PA 16001.

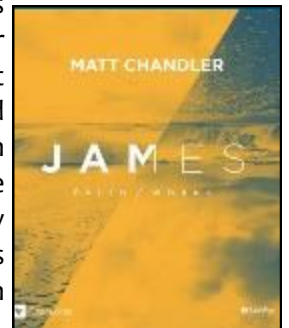
