Expository Preaching. Why do we do it?

Last Sunday I gave you an article on our new direction of teaching every word as we walk through entire books of the Bible together. In that article I gave you six reasons for why we will be doing it that way. Over the next several weeks I will be breaking down those six reasons.

1. It's the example that we see in the Bible.

All through the Bible, expository teaching is how we see God's men communicating. God's spokesman doesn't come up with fancy sayings or give his own message to the people, he gives the message of God to the people.

In **Deuteronomy 1:3** - it says Moses spoke to the people all that the Lord had given Him.

In **Nehemiah 8** - we see the prophet Ezra open the written Word of God, reads it and explain it.

In **Matthew 5** - Jesus continually says, "you've heard it said... well I say to you" - He quotes what they know from the text then explains the meaning.

In **Acts 2:14-40** - Peter preaches at Pentecost and quotes from the Old Testament, then explains it.

In **1 Timothy 4:13** - Paul commends us to read scripture, exhort scripture, and teach scripture.

There are many more examples throughout scripture of expository preaching. These 5 have been selected because they cover every era throughout history. From the law, to the prophets, to the time of Christ, to the apostles and their unique gifting, to us today, God has always worked through expository teaching. God's Word will never fail. So like the examples scripture gives us, just tell people what God said, He has already said it the best. ~Jake

One Church: End of the Year Update
