A NEW YEAR... A NEW DIRECTION

It's officially a new year - 2021. Throughout this year North Street Church will be following the direction that we began in 2020. We will continue to walk through the book of John and cover every verse. This is not just our plan for the book of John. Teaching every word as we go straight through entire books is what we intend to do for a long time to come. This is why we describe ourselves as an Expository Bible Church. We are setting forth the meaning of the text and covering all of it.

We do it this way for 6 main reasons.

- 1- It's the example we see in the Bible
- 2- It establishes the authority of God over those hearing
- 3- Christ is the Head of the church
- 4- The Holy Spirit works in accordance with the Word of God
- 5- It shows submission to Gods Word
- 6- It gives people the only real source for help

Expository Preaching is the earnest and urgent teaching that comes from a view that holds scripture as complete and inerrant. In the same way that anyone's words combined with the context they were spoken give off a specific meaning, God's word delivers to us a specific meaning that God intended for the reader to grasp. Expository preaching takes the text that God wrote and explains it to the listener. This makes the preacher himself a simple tool which gives voice to God's text. Expository preaching requires one to present the text before the listeners, explain the text before the listener to submit to the text. It is the true way to preach, and the model of preaching that we see in the pages of scripture itself.
