God's Patience Leads to Salvation

When looking at the attributes of God, it is important to remember that they all exist together. In no way is God some of one thing without being the others as well. In other words, all of God's acts require all of His attributes. In this short article I want to look at the patience of God. 1 Peter 3:20 says, "...when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark..." It took 120 years for the ark to be built, which displays some patience to us. If we go through the whole Old Testament, we would see the patience of God with Israel over and over again. The Bible refers to God as slow to anger in many places. Now Peter used the example of Noah building the ark to encourage his readers to not fall into the false teaching that Christ was not coming back. Just because it seems like it's taking some time from our side of things does not mean you can forget the patience of God. Peter tells them to count the patience of God as salvation. That statement means the reason we are still here and people are still given a chance at eternal life is because God is patient. God is long-suffering and will come in judgment, but the fact that He hasn't yet means salvation for some. Every individual that rejects God, that chooses temporary pleasures instead of Glorifying Him, that worships creation rather than the creator, deserves destruction. The reason that God hasn't destroyed us all is that His patience is giving people a chance to repent and find salvation through Christ. Now, if God Who has been dishonored more than we can ever imagine is that patient because He wants to see people saved, don't you think we should model ourselves after Him and long for the salvation of others as well. Thank God for His patience, and allow it to motivate you to share the gospel boldly. For God loves when sinners repent and salvation is received.

Another Reason to Celebrate

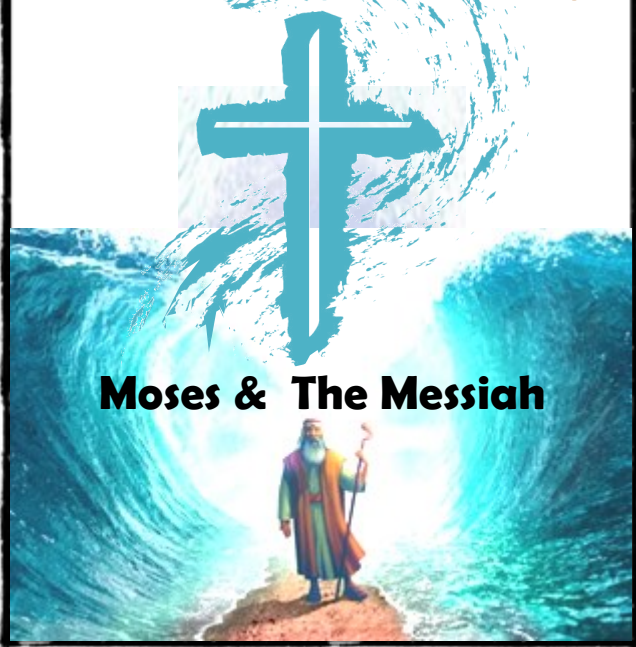
