### God the Just Judge

In this article we talk about the just nature of God. Last week we focused on how God is merciful which we see in Him withholding from us what we deserve. Now, a penalty for poor behavior is important. Look at any child who has no discipline and you will see the result of not giving that child what they deserve. However, that's exactly what God did for us. For God to be just, He has to punish sin. God can't just ignore it, that would be a flaw in His character. It's the just nature of God that must punish sin justly. God's wrath against sin had to be poured out and the result had to be death. Last week we said God's mercy postponed judgment for some and paid it for others. The fact that God is just is why it couldn't just be canceled. The judge that ignored sin is not a good judge. Therefore, the just nature of God will require many to pay for their sin with an eternity in Hell. Those that reject Jesus will feel the full weight of God's just nature. But, a payment has been made. Jesus Christ willingly went to the cross and took the penalty for us. God poured out His wrath for sin on the sinless one Jesus Christ. God didn't ignore your sin, He punished it by delivering the full weight of His anger on Jesus Christ. In 1 Peter 2:24, it says, "He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness." You see, God set us free from the penalty of sin and washed us free of guilt, while still remaining true to His own holy law by providing a substitute in Christ. God is just and a justifier through the Savior, Jesus.
