Sovereign = Total Control

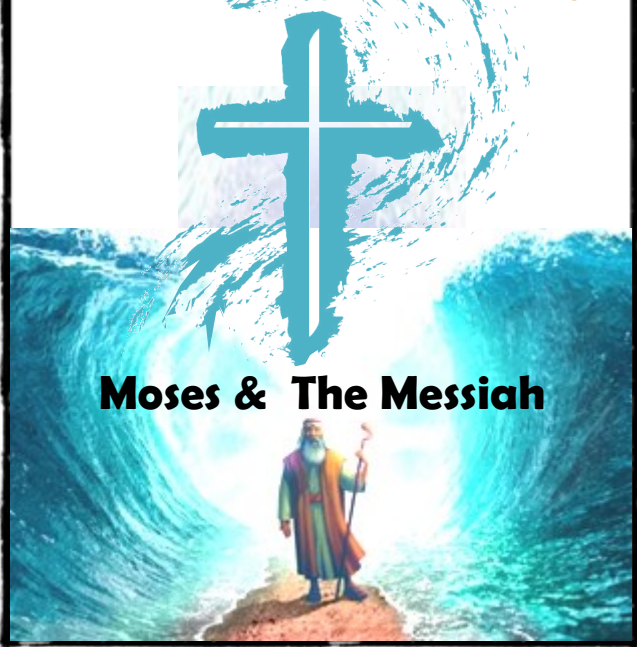
