ULTIMATE POWER

We study the Bible to know God. It is a book that reveals to us the nature of who God is. Because of our desire to know God, we are looking at the qualities of God-His character. We have looked at how God is loving, unchanging, and everywhere. Today we look at how God is all-powerful. The fact that God is all-powerful means there is nothing He can't do. We often refer to Him as "almighty God" because His might is without end. He is so powerful! Revelation 19:6 states the great multitude worships saying, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty reigns." Scripture often refers to the power of God, and we see it displayed throughout the text. In creation, God spoke into existence the universe with ease. Psalm 33 says that He spoke, and it was done. The reality of God's limitless power is hard to wrap our brains around. He can do anything He wants, and He does not get weary from doing it. Thinking through this, men can split an atom and create a massive explosion, but God created the atom with ease and didn't even break a sweat! There are a lot of ways that we can apply this practically, but for today let's focus on just one: trust. Since God is all-powerful and can do whatever He wants, who are we to question what God does? The power of God being limitless puts Him in control of all things. The proper response from us is to worship. The Christian is called to worship regardless of what is happening, because they know the all-powerful God that can do anything. We can go into any situation with confidence, knowing that God is in control and God can and will complete His task for His purpose. Marvel in the fact that God is all-powerful, and worship Him because of it.
