God ~ The Ultimate Know it All

True believers long to know God. Maturity happens as we develop our understanding of who God is. One of the great things about our God is that He revealed exactly what we needed Him to. It's impossible to understand God completely! His attributes are infinite, but the Bible tells us so much about who God is—and it's exactly what we need. We have looked at several qualities of God so far, but today we focus on the fact that God is omniscient. That means that God knows absolutely everything. One who knows everything has nothing to learn. God has never learned anything because there has never been anything He didn't know. Psalm 147:5 states that "His understanding is infinite." This means that nothing is unknowable for God—He knows it all. When we think of the infinite wisdom of God and recognize that He knows everything we must realize that includes us. God knows every aspect of you inside and out. This means that God knows your wicked thoughts. God knows your secret sin. God knows your every word and isn't taken by surprise when you say it. When I think about my own life, I stand amazed at the fact that God knows everything about me inside and out, yet still loves me and holds my salvation secure. The omniscience of God is a great thing, but so is His mercy, grace and love. Practically speaking, let the omniscience of God help keep you from sinning. You are not getting away with anything. God knows everything. Marvel at the fact that He knows you and still loves you, and acknowledge the fact that He sees and knows everything you are doing. In school when you wanted to cheat on a test you made sure the teacher wasn't looking, but God is always looking. Live accordingly!
