Today's Text: Luke 2:8-10

When we think of Christmas gifts, we often think of something pretty. To us, it's something polished, or fun, or packaged. Even if a gift is perfectly wrapped and is entertaining, people return things that don't meet any needs or fulfill any desires. That's how all of life is. One doesn't long for help unless they know they are sick or in danger. The true meaning of Christmas is no different. Lots of people will celebrate Christmas this week, but they don't realize the need they have for Jesus Christ, the one we are celebrating. There is a disease upon the souls of men called sin. "All have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God," Romans 3:23. When people don't recognize their depravity, they can't recognize the need for Jesus Christ. Christ's being born was not simply to give us something to celebrate; He came to save His people from their sins. So recognize the deadly disease that is destroying you and leads to death, sin. Then celebrate the Savior who is our only hope.
