God is More Than Love

When you think of God, you probably think of love. The Bible says that God is love, and those who believe in God believe that about Him. But while love is the most thought of attribute of God, it's also the least understood. Many people think of God's love as something greater than His justice or holy anger. It is often viewed as a trump all card that erases those other attributes or frees one from facing judgment because God is loving. But when God's love is presented as His only quality or as divinely bestowed upon everyone no matter what, it works against understanding His love. Psalm 38 tells us that God's wrath burns against sinners. We can't let God's love remove the reality of God's wrath. The message of the cross is the meeting of God's love and wrath. He pours out His wrath for sin on Christ, the substitute, because He loves His people. You see, without a proper view of God's wrath, one can never understand the beautiful reality of God's love. We should marvel at the love of God but also put it in its proper place with the other qualities of God that scripture reveals.
