Thankfulness

Psalm 107 is my favorite chapter in the Bible for thanksgiving. I go to this text often and rejoice at God's saving work in my life. The Psalm starts with a call to give thanks to the Lord in v.1. Then the psalmist repeats this call to thankfulness in verse 8, verse 15, verse 21, and verse 31. The psalmist paints four different pictures, all depicting despair and desperation. In all four of these situations, the man finds himself in trouble, and he cries out to the Lord, who graciously delivers him from the disaster. The end of each picture is the psalmist repeating the call to thanksgiving for God's lovingkindness and wonderful works to men. All true Christians have been in a place of despair over their own sin. You get to a place of feeling helpless and broken, poor in spirit. That crushing of self-righteous pride is depicted in this Psalm, and the Lord's gracious salvation should leave us forever thankful. So no matter what you have going on in your life, stop often to worship and thank the God who saved you and pulled you from your despair.
